POSTER CHAMP AWARD

UEG awards the 15 best posters on the basis of scientific merit using the evaluation process of the UEG Scientific Committee. The Award Ceremony will be held each day in the poster exhibition area. Prize winners will receive free entry to the Postgraduate Training Programme of the following year's UEG Week.

DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST:

UEG is committed to ensuring scientific rigour and objectivity in all of its educational activities. These include all aspects of the educational programme at UEG Week including those that are directly and jointly sponsored activities. All presenters, whether invited Faculty or abstract presenters, are required to disclose to those organising and attending meetings any relevant financial or other relationship that may lead to a potential bias. UEG reserves the right to review the information disclosed for potential conflicts of interest. Please note that the sole responsibility for the content of each presentation lies with the presenting author.

The UEG Scientific Committee requires all presenters to disclose any advisory or consultancy roles in the Biomedical Industry during the past two years. These and any other potential conflicts of interest should be disclosed verbally during introductory comments to the presentation. Invited speakers and oral abstract presenters are requested to disclose potential conflicts of interest on a PowerPoint slide to be shown immediately at the beginning of the presentation. **Poster presenters are requested to disclose potential conflicts of interest at the bottom of their poster.** Conflicts of interest may exist through a financial relationship or when the individual has the opportunity to influence the content of a

presentation, and can involve grants, honoraria, shares, paid positions on advisory boards, etc. Conflicts of interest are frequent and expected, and do not preclude an individual from making a presentation providing the conflict is disclosed. If there is any doubt about the relevance of a potential conflict of interest UEG requires all presenters to err on the safe side and to disclose it.

PRESENTING AUTHOR:

Please keep in mind the Declaration you signed when submitting the abstract: "... Submission of an abstract constitutes a formal commitment by the author to present the abstract in the session and at the time decided upon by the UEG Scientific Committee. If the original presenting author is unable to present the abstract it is that person's responsibility to ensure that one of the co-authors take over this role. Failure to present the abstract, for other than well founded reasons, will lead to rejection of abstract submission at the next Congress."

If any changes in the presenting author occur, the presenting author needs to be updated by **Sunday, July 20, 2014** directly on the abstract submission form by using your login details created during submission.

TO CHANGE THE PRESENTING AUTHOR, PLEASE:

2. Select the abstract you wish to amend
3. Click on "view and modify"
4. Chose the "author" section for modification and click on "Go"
5. Change the presenting author by clicking on the pencil symbol

Any changes received after **Sunday, July 20, 2014** cannot be integrated in the Final Programme nor in the Abstract Book as online supplement to the UEG Journal.

WITHDRAWAL OF ABSTRACTS

If you need to withdraw your abstract, a written statement reflecting the reasons for this decision must be sent to uegweek2014abs@mci-group.com by **Sunday, July 20, 2014**.

REGISTRATION:

As the author of an accepted abstract, you still have the possibility to register online, with the reduced, EARLY registration fee. The registration deadline for the EARLY registration fee is **Wednesday, September 10, 2014**.
